

NOTICE OF TAX REVENUE INCREASE

The Howard County Junior College District conducted public hearings on Wednesday, September 7, 2016, and Monday, September 12, 2016, on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Howard County Junior College District from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 3.32 percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.251623 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$8,442,826.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.313798 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$8,686,494.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.313798 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$8,785,689.

The Board of Trustees of the Howard County Junior College District is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 26, 2016, at Howard College, in the Tumbleweed Room of the Student Union Building, 1001 Birdwell Lane, Big Spring, Texas 79720 at 12:30 p.m.

The Howard County Junior College District proposes to use the increase in total tax revenue for the purpose of maintenance and operations such as personnel costs, fire alarm building upgrades, capital outlay, coliseum chiller, deferred maintenance projects and marketing.
