Howard College and TTUHSC Early Decision Admission



Howard College students who meet Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center School of Nursing admission requirements upon completion of an ADN at Howard College will receive provisional admission to TTUHSC School of Nursing. The articulation agreement between these schools allows students to plan and prepare by making the early decision to attend the TTUHSC School of Nursing RN to BSN program. Upon successful completion of the Howard College ADN program, along with meeting the eligibility and admission requirements for the TTUHSC School of Nursing RN to BSN program, students can complete their BSN in as little as two semesters. Students may be eligible for early decision admission status by completing and sending in a Declaration of Intent (DOI) form during their ADN coursework at Howard College. Howard College will be notified of the filling of this Declaration of Intent, and TTUHSC School of Nursing will confirm with Howard College that the student is in good academic standing at the time of filling the intent. The program is designed for the full-time working nurse and has a low student to faculty ratio. The program highlights are that it's convenient, affordable and has stellar graduation and retention rates.

Eligibility Requirements of Howard ADN Students

To be eligible, you *must* complete the following steps:

- 1. Complete a Declaration of Intent (DOI) form is highly preferred and strongly recommended during the first semester of coursework at Howard College. Students who do not complete the DOI in their first semester may still complete the early decision agreement and are recommended to contact the RN-BSN Advisor and Application Coach.
- 2. Submit a formal application to the RN to BSN Program at TTUHSC: and meet all minimum admission requirements.
- Upon completion of your ADN education and after receiving an admission offer to the TTUHSC School of Nursing's RN to BSN program, you will be provisionally admitted and may take three courses, NURS 4343 Foundations of Nursing Knowledge, NURS 4342 Evidence into Practice and NURS 4233 Art of the Human Experience.
- 4. For provisionally admitted students, upon passing the NCLEX examination (RN licensure exam), you will be granted full admission to the RN to BSN program and may enroll in full-time studies the following semester
