Students wishing to pursue a Teacher Certification will minor in Education. To obtain a Teacher Certification, students must have at least a C in their core competency classes as well as the following classes: HIST 1301 & 1302, GOVT 2305 & 2306, ENGL 1301 & 1302, MATH, SPCH 1315.
