Instead, they recommend students take ASU’s Intensive Spanish courses—1301 and 1302 in one semester, and 2311 and 2312 in the next semester—paying careful attention to how the foreign language is explained in the textbook and how the professor has the students practice the language in class and how students are assessed/tested. Students in this situation may need to transfer to ASU prior to completing an Associate Degree at Howard College.
