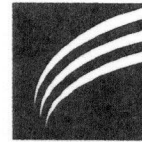

Howard College and Lubbock Christian University do hereby enter into an articulation agreement regarding the professional preparation of teachers.

Howard College pledges to make prospective and current students aware of this articulation agreement, including information regarding the agreement in its catalog and notifying its liaison of any changes that might affect the agreement.

Lubbock Christian University pledges to accept the Howard College Associate of Arts in Teaching degree in lieu of the Lubbock Christian University Core Curriculum as stipulated below and will notify its liaison of any changes that might affect the agreement.


In addition to the Associate of Arts in Teaching degree at Howard College, interested students must meet the following conditions of admission to the Lubbock Christian University Educator Preparation Program.

- Complete six hours of Bible courses at Lubbock Christian University
- Complete appropriate interdisciplinary/teaching field courses
- Meet all other non-curricular requirements for admission as expressed in the University catalog (GPA, THEA, application to the program, etc.)

Appropriate faculty members are to represent each institution as program liaisons. The liaisons are to communicate regularly regarding program procedures and requirements, student recruitment and advisement, changes in degree plans, and other relevant issues.


This agreement is to begin on November 1, 2012 and is to be reviewed after five years to determine whether there is sufficient interest to continue the agreement. Both institutions must agree to renew the agreement at that time for it to continue.
