STUDENT CONCERNS	Assigned Response
RESIDENCE HALLS	
The temperature in the softball and basketball rooms in the women's dorm is too warm and very uncomfortable.	Fabian Serrano
Response: Most HCBS buildings, including the Turner Residence Hall, are heated and cooled with a chilled water and hot water closed loop system. Because the chilled water lines for the women's dorm are exposed on the roof, they must be drained if we have several consecutive days of below freezing temperatures as we did in January. Not draining those exposed chilled water lines during those cold days would cause them to burst. Our plan was to restore the chilled water supply to the women's dorm yesterday, but we now have an underground chilled water supply leak west of Turner Hall that is preventing us from supplying chilled water to Turner Hall and the Science Building. We hope to have this fixed within the next week to restore comfortable temperatures within the buildings. In the meantime, please turn off each unit within the dorm room when it gets too warm.	
The men's hall smells like marijuana. It has been very bad in the past. Seems to be getting better.	Christi Fenter
Response: We are addressing this issue.	
The furniture in the men's dorm lobby is falling apart.	Christi Fenter
Response: We are budgeting to have the furniture recovered. If we have extra funds this year, we will begin having furniture recovered.
