





## Registration Checklist for Dependents using Dependents Educational Assistance (DEA) VA Education Benefits

- o Apply for admission to Howard College at <a href="https://www.applytexas.org/adappc/gen/c">https://www.applytexas.org/adappc/gen/c</a> start.WBX
  - o Make sure to select Howard College Big Spring
- Visit the Howard College Financial Aid web site at <a href="https://howardcollege.edu/students/financial-aid-and-scholarships/">https://howardcollege.edu/students/financial-aid-and-scholarships/</a> to learn about grants, loans and scholarships available.
  - We encourage all students to apply for Financial Aid, even if you don't think you will qualify for anything. Apply for financial aid at <a href="https://fafsa.ed.gov/">https://fafsa.ed.gov/</a>
- Apply to use your VA Education Benefits at <a href="https://www.vets.gov/education/apply/">https://www.vets.gov/education/apply/</a>
  - After the Veteran Benefits Administration (VBA) has processed your application, they will generate a
    Certificate of Eligibility (COE). Submit a copy of to the Veterans Advisor. Normally takes about 30 days
    to arrive via mail
- Get advised and enroll in classes
  - Meet with Veteran Advisor to discuss degree options and get registered for classes. You can look over degrees and certificates offered by Howard College at http://catalog.howardcollege.edu/content.php?catoid=13&navoid=522
  - o If needed, apply for Student Disability Services, more info at https://howardcollege.edu/ada/
- o Submit Statement of Understanding and VA Benefit Student Information Packet to the Veteran Advisor
