The following information will be submitted to Castlebranch for official review. Compliance with all vaccine requirements must be verified via acceptable evidence for a student to be eligible for acceptance to the program. **This form is not considered acceptable evidence.**

Additional Information

Hepatitis B: Applicants must show proof upon application to the program of receiving the full series. Applicants that have never had the vaccine will be required to take the series. Applicants that received the Hepatitis B vaccine as a baby must get a Hepatitis B titer (blood test) to check for antibodies to the virus. If immune, the applicant has completed this requirement. If no immunity is identified, applicants must contact a physician/licensed provider to receive a minimum of one challenge dose and another titer or determine if a full series is indicated. All documentation (proof of series, titer, etc.) must be submitted.

Varicella: Applicants that have never had the vaccine nor the virus (chicken pox) as a child will be required to get a Varicella titer (blood test) to check for antibodies to the virus. If immune, the applicant has completed this requirement. If no immunity is identified, applicants must contact a physician/licensed provider to receive the series. All documentation (proof of series, titer, etc.) must be submitted. Parental acknowledgment of previous disease as a child is not considered acceptable evidence.

MMR: Applicants that have never had the vaccine will be required to get an MMR titer (blood test) to check for antibodies to the virus. If immune, the applicant has completed this requirement. If no immunity is identified, applicants must contact a physician/licensed provider to receive the series. All documentation (proof of series, titer, etc.) must be submitted.

Tdap: Applicants must show proof of receiving Tdap once within the last 10 years. If over 10 years since the Tdap was received, the applicant must receive another Tdap. All documentation must be submitted.

TB Test: Applicants must show proof of receiving a TB skin test. A TB blood test or TB chest x-ray is an acceptable substitute for the skin test. Either method must demonstrate non-reactivity or deemed clear (x-ray). Applicants must contact a physician/licensed provider to determine which is appropriate if uncertain. This is an annual test while in the program. All documentation must be submitted.

Bacterial Meningitis: Applicants under the age of 22 years old must receive a meningitis injection to meet the Howard College general admission requirements. Documentation must be submitted.

Influenza: Applicants are strongly encouraged to receive the flu shot. Off-campus enrichment sites may require it. Documentation must be submitted.

Note:

Acceptable documentation includes:

- proof of vaccines (month/day/year received) from physician/licensed provider/health clinic
- laboratory confirmation of immunity
- laboratory confirmation of disease

Acceptable documentation does not include:

- self-disclosure of disease
- parental acknowledgement of disease
