Student Conduct

Student agrees to abide by the terms and conditions of this contract, District Catalog, Student Handbook, Residence Hall Supplement, and other rules and regulations governing the conduct of students which are now in effect and any that may be reviewed and published at a later date. The Student Handbook may be found by at: www.howardcollege.edu/swcd under "Students". **It is the student's responsibility to become knowledgeable of policies and procedures.**

All apartments are subject to entry at reasonable times by residence hall supervisors and other college officials to check the condition of apartments, the need for repairs, or to make repairs. The college reserves the right to enter any apartment to maintain discipline and to provide security of student's property. If possible, apartment entry will be arranged in advance; however, authorized representatives of the college shall have the immediate right to enter in case of an emergency or when circumstances warrant strong evidence of violation of college policies. In order to control for the use of illegal drugs in the residence complex, the District reserves the right to use the services of law enforcement and/or private agencies to search for drugs in the residence complex, including students' apartments at any time. These searches may be conducted on a random basis and without notice to students.

Liability

Although SWCD/Howard College and the Housing department will exercise reasonable efforts to protect student property, SWCD/Howard College and the Housing department are not liable for loss from theft or damage to any property belonging to students or guest. All students are urged to make sure that **personal properties** are covered by insurance, either with their parents' homeowners' insurance policy or by a special student policy available for this specific purpose by an insurance firm specializing in this type of coverage.
