Course Description

The course consists of 4 weeks (160 hours) of intense training. The 40 hour classroom phase covers an introduction to truck transportation (orientation, history, and development of American trucking, etc.) and regulatory agencies (city, county, state, and federal regulation).

Beginning in the second week, the student learns preventive maintenance (inspection procedures, gasoline and diesel theory, systems and components, etc.). Also during this phase, the student moves on to safe driving procedures and basic driving skills on the driving range.

Weeks three and four cover intermediate and advanced driving skills, safety, and defensive driving and includes highway driving.

Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of training you will have the knowledge and skills to obtain a Commercial Drivers License (CDL) from the Department of Public Safety.

Admission Requirements:

- Student must be 18 years of age or older
- The student must pass the Department of Transportation examination, including but not limited to urinalysis drug screening.
- A high school diploma, GED, or Ability to Benefit Entrance Test is required for enrollment. If you have a diploma or GED, you must provide a copy to A.C.T..
- Texas driver's license
- Social Security card
