The Student is responsible for PALS course is to improve the quality of care provided to seriously ill or injured children, resulting in improved outcomes.

Learning Outcomes

- •Perform high quality child CPR AED & infant CPR per AHA Basic Life Support recommendations.
- ·Recognize cardiopulmonary arrest early
- •Differentiate between respiratory distress and failure, and perform early interventions for both and between compensated and decompensated(hypotensive) shock, and perform early interventions for the treatment of shock.
- •Differentiate between unstable and stable patients with arrhythmias: and apply team dynamics.
