PHARMACY TECHNICIAN TRAINING

Course Description

The Pharmacy Technician program prepares students with the skills and abilities essential for work in one of many pharmacy settings. The blended program consist of in person lecture and the clinicals in various Pharmacy's. Topics include filing and labeling prescriptions; interacting with customers to answer questions or give them their prescriptions; assembling, stocking and distributing medications; recording and filing the prescriptions and orders of Physicians; and monitoring inventory. Students who successfully complete this course are eligible to apply to take the national certification exam.

Applicant's Responsibilities

- *Must be a minimum of 18 years of age.
- *Must provide official high school transcript or GED transcript
- ${\bf *Prior}\ to\ acceptance,\ applicant\ {\bf must}\ pass\ {\bf drug\ screen}.$
- *Each student must have a background check and fingerprinting through State Approved Vendor. Students must also apply to be a Pharmacy Technician Trainee.
- *Upon registration, students **must** bring their current CPR certification, social security card, driver's license, and shot records showing they have had: TDAP, MMR, Varicella, Hepatitis B Series, Flu shot, and TB Test.
- *Textbook is needed on first day of class.
- *Red & black scrubs are required
